

General English

15 Hours per Week

For those who want to strengthen everyday communication, our General English course helps students gain fluency and confidence in speaking, listening, reading, and writing. Lessons are dynamic, practical, and focused on real-life English — preparing students for both daily interactions and future goals.



Intensive English

21 Hours per Week

Looking for faster progress? The Intensive English option adds extra lessons each week, allowing deeper focus on chosen areas like conversation, pronunciation, or writing skills. With smaller groups and hands-on practice, students quickly see measurable improvement in their fluency and accuracy.



Academic Study & Work Programme

25 Weeks +
8 Weeks Holiday

This long-term programme is ideal for international students who want to study, work, and live in Ireland.

25 weeks of classes (15 hours per week) build language skills step by step.

8 weeks of holidays give time to travel, relax, or work full-time.

During class weeks, students can **work up to 20 hours per week**, gaining valuable professional experience while studying.

Erasmus+ Programmes

For European learners and professionals, Erin College delivers specialised Erasmus+ mobility and training courses. Each programme blends classroom learning with cultural discovery, helping participants improve their English, broaden their perspectives, and develop key skills for study or career growth in the EU context.

Teacher Training Courses CLIL & Methodology

Designed for educators, our teacher training programmes combine modern teaching theory with hands-on workshops.

CLIL Training: Learn to teach academic subjects in English using interactive, bilingual techniques.

English Methodology: Explore communicative teaching strategies, classroom management, and effective assessment.

Participants engage in micro-teaching sessions, use digital tools, and take part in cultural visits. Courses run year-round (1-2 weeks) and are fully eligible for Erasmus+ funding.





PCTO and EU-Funded Projects

Erin College collaborates with high schools and European institutions to deliver PCTO (Italy's career-based learning) and other EU-funded initiatives.

Projects integrate English language learning with career workshops, company visits, and innovation in digital education.

Through our Erasmus+ partnerships, we also participate in initiatives promoting green campuses, youth exchanges, and creative approaches to language teaching — helping shape the future of international education.

- Flexible durations and international classrooms.



